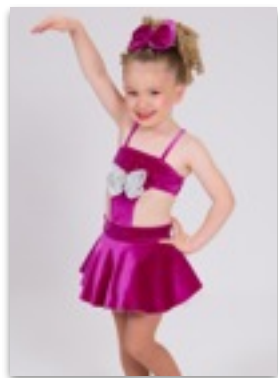

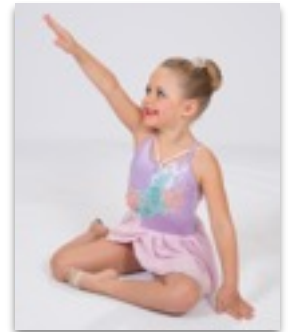


TINY-TOTS (2 - 5.5 years)

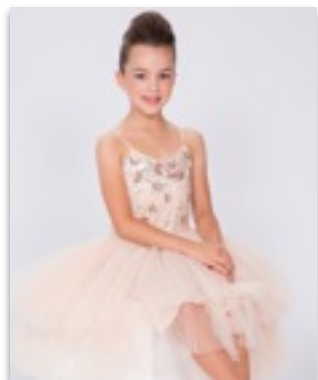
PRE-JUNIOR CLASSES (4.5 - 6.5years)

Step 3: Select styles your child wishes to take.

Please note: we offer first week of FREE trials. We encourage students to attend & take part in ALL lessons / classes in their age group for their first week. Students can then select the classes they enjoyed the most & wish to participate in for term 1. Parents will be invoiced for the chosen classes AFTER trial week. Trial week is week 1 of term 1!

STYLES:

Tiny-tots: 2 - 5.5years (Pre-school)

Kindergym/Acrobatics - one 30min class combining 2 styles

Jazz / Tap / Ballet - one 45min class combining all 3 styles

Music/Singing/Drama - one 30min class combining all 3 styles

All other age groups: (Pre-Junior, Junior, Intermediate & Seniors)

Jazz - fast up beat movements to fun & energetic dance music

Tap - using tap shoes, tap classes are loud & fun

Classical Ballet - traditional classical ballet, using the Australian Conservatorie of Ballet syllabus (ballet is only available to competition students at this stage - exams are also available, please phone Miss Alisha to discuss)

Acrobatics- gymnastic elements, jumps, splits, tumbling, motor co-ordination, agility, flexibility, strength & balance

Cheer - Available for Senior/Intermediate students only.

Lyrical/Contemporary - modern music, using emotion & song lyrics to choreograph a slow & dynamic dance

Hip Hop - street style of dance using hip hop music, energetic & big movements

Musical Theatre - theatrical performance that combines, songs, spoken, dancing, singing & acting

Singing - vocal technique & music literacy

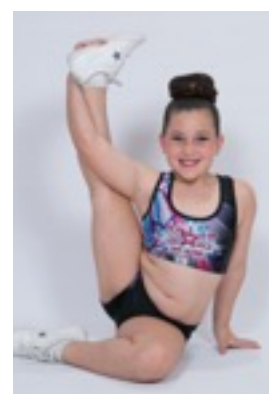
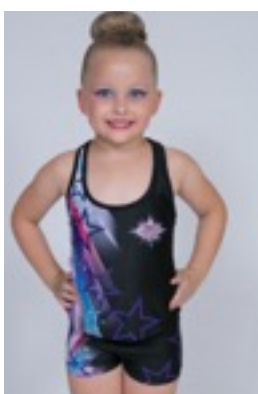

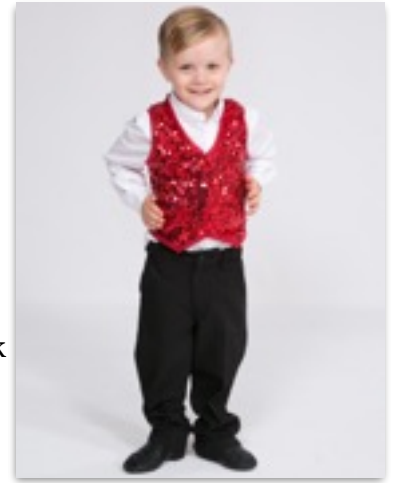

Starz on Stage Talent Academy (PTY LTD) Terms & conditions

1. Students must be well groomed at all times, jewellery is not permitted to be worn at classes. Students must wear correct uniform & footwear to classes. School uniforms must not be worn, under any circumstances - this includes singing private lessons.
2. Students are to respect our studio, its cleanliness, keep belongings neat + tidy & food scraps in the bins provided. We ask that elder students take pride in their personal hygiene.
3. If a student will be absent please notify admin/staff/principal via email, phone or text before classes. All missed lessons must be paid for, in some cases make up lessons can be arranged if a child misses their class.
4. Bullying is not tolerated! Students are to be kind & respectful towards their fellow students, teachers & the principal.
5. Parents, families & students must address staff / teachers / principal in a respectful & friendly manner.
6. It is important parents are aware that teaching / coaching may involve physical contact for correct placement & spotting.
7. Parents & students must be respectful to our neighbours, keep noise to a minimum, do not park in their driveways & please leave promptly after class.
8. Parents, families and students are not to speak negatively about Starz on Stage, its teachers, principal or students. Please discuss any issue you may have with the company director only.
9. Students enrolled at SOS are not permitted to dance/sing at another studio without prior consent from the principal.
10. Students must attend all classes unless in the event they are ill. If a student is away and misses too much choreography it will effect their placement in the Showcase & end of year Concert. We ask that you do not plan family holidays / functions when students are required for classes, photo shoots or concerts. Check 2018 calendar and note all important dates in your diary or planner.
11. World health organisation recommends children avoid contact for 48hours after infectious illness (i.e vomiting / diarrhoea)
12. Parents are not permitted to watch classes unless a prior arrangement has been made with the principal.
13. Students must be on their best behaviour at all times, any student found continually mis-behaving will have their parents phoned.
14. Parents please be mindful not to drop your child off too early to the studio. A maximum of 5 - 10mins early is permitted. Students must wait quietly in student lounge & not distract classes / private lessons in the studio. Students are allowed to wait a maximum of 5 -10mins in the student lounge after their classes have finished if their parent/guardian is late to collect. Longer use of the student lounge is not permitted, if on occasion parents need to drop children earlier then 5 - 10 mins or collect later then 5 - 10mins of classes - please phone the office prior to advise staff.
15. Its important parents are aware that students use the students lounge with out direct adult supervision. Staff are busy teaching/working & can not supervise children or help with making dinners & use of the kitchen facilities. Students are welcome to bring an ipod/ipad to use whilst waiting in the student lounge, however under no circumstances are students to take photos of any other student whilst at the SOS studio.
16. Choreography of solo + group routines taught by any member of the SOS staff remains property of Starz on Stage Talent Academy. Students forfeit ALL of their solo/group routines if they do not continue lessons at SOS.
17. Parents / guardians are to not to post video's of their child's solo or group routines on Facebook, instagram, snap or chat or any other social media without written consent from the principal.
18. It is understood that all students take classes at their own risk and no liability under any circumstances shall be taken by the principal or teachers for injury or loss of personal property (including 2nd hand shoes placed in the shoe box).
19. Parents give Starz on Stage Talent Academy permission to use photos / videos taken of their child at classes / concerts / events for advertising purposes, including & not limited to Facebook, Instagram, newspapers, flyers & other media.
20. If you choose to cease your enrolment at Starz on Stage in 2018, parents must notify the principal via email, or fees will be continue to be charged.
21. If you are on Facebook please ask to join the private group: "Starz on stage parents & students" to keep up to date on all information. Communication is the key, parents must check their email or the front notice board at the studio on a weekly basis. Please read all newsletters carefully to avoid missing important information. The staff at SOS work hard on typing newsletters each week so parents can stay informed and always have plenty of notice of events & other information. Keeping up to date is parents responsibility , if you haven't received an email from us recently let us know. Please ensure our emails are not going to junk. You will receive emails from XERO, Dance studio-pro & Starz on Stage Talent Academy.
22. Our fees are by the term regardless of how many weeks - weekly payers must pay full term amount prior to week 7 of term.
23. In accordance with the fair trading Act there are NO refunds on enrolment, registration, costumes, uniforms or term fees.
24. Fees must be paid on time or late payment fees will incur. In the event fees are overdue, students may be asked to sit out of classes. To ensure continued enrolment at Starz on Stage, please pay your account on time.
25. Costume account must be paid IN FULL by August 1st 2018. Costumes will not be purchased / made for students who have not paid. Parents can make instalments towards costumes from the beginning of term 2.
26. Students will not be permitted to dance/perform in the Showcase, or Concert if accounts & invoices are overdue.
27. Overdue/ unpaid term fees, costume accounts & invoices will incur a \$15 a month late fee. All unpaid accounts will be forwarded to our companies debt collection agency. Further fees and charges will be added by the agency that must be paid by account holders.
